Getting to Kenosha

By Boat: Kenosha has two large harbors, Southport, which is a short walk from the Public Museums, where we will be holding our Saturday events, and Simmons Island Harbor on the north side, near the yacht club.

By Train: Kenosha has a Metra train station, which is served by the Union Pacific North Line out of Chicago's Ogilvie Transportation Center. It is the end of the line, with only a handful of trains a day. But coming by train is an option and the station isn't far from the harbor area.

By Car: Of course, you can always come by car. Public parking is available at the museum campus and along the city streets. Kenosha is a major tourist destination, even when the Tall Ships are not in port. If coming by car, arrive early to beat the crowds.



Where to Stay?

There are two hotels downtown Kenosha.

Wyndham Garden Kenosha Harborside, which overlooks the harbor where the Tall Ships will be docked. We could only get a small block of rooms at a discount. You can see if any are still available by calling 262-358-9566 and mentioning United States Power Squadrons. Once our block is gone, you'll have to pay the current room rate.

Opening soon is the *Stella Hotel and Ballroom*. Located in a newly remodeled 100-year-old building in downtown Kenosha. They will begin accepting reservations the first week of April. You can learn more at StellaHotel.com or calling 262-842-2000.

There are a variety of hotels about 8 miles from the harbor. As Kenosha is a weekend destination, these hotels can book up on weekends. It's recommended to get your rooms sooner, rather than later. There are also boutique hotels and B&B options in Kenosha, which you can find on the various web sites that specialize in those services.



Marinas and Docking

Southport Marina is allowing USPS members to book transient slips before they are available to the general public. To book now, call the marina at 262-657-5565 or email cs@spmarina.net with your name, boat name, length and credit card info to reserve your slip. Be sure to mention you are with the Power Squadron. They can handle boats up to 60'. Most slips will have 50-amp power, so be sure to bring a converter if you need one.

Simmons Island Harbor is another option, but only for powerboats, as there is a fixed bridge to consider as you enter the harbor. They can accommodate boats up to 44'. Their number is 262-653-3910.

America's Boating Club members will be working the festival on Friday & Sunday and serve at least two four-hour shifts. We will concentrate on Friday afternoon for the first shift and a second shift on Sunday morning.

We will organize into groups of eight so we can serve together on the same ships. Tasks will include checking wrist bands prior to boarding, assisting guests onto the boat and serving as docents.



Parade of Sail

Thursday afternoon is the Parade of Sail for the tall ships prior to docking in Kenosha for the weekend. America's Boating Club members and their boats will serve as a security perimeter for the event under the supervision of the US Coast Guard and Tall Ships organizers.

Saturday Events

The Daimler-Chrysler Hall at the Public Museum opens at 10am for our Saturday activities. We'll have a Friendship Room with pastries and coffee available in the morning. Followed by the Council Meeting at 11am.

After the meeting, we'll have a group luncheon with salads, deli sandwiches, along with the side dishes and beverages.

After lunch, you can tour the Tall Ships or Sail Away on a tall ship for an 80-minute cruise and view of the Kenosha skyline. (see last page for sign up details).

Saturday evening, we'll have our Sundowner party at the harbor.



We will be doing fund raising to help offset the cost of meeting rooms and expenses associated with the weekend. We would love to have individuals or squadrons donate gift baskets or other items. Baskets or items should be brought to the Wyndham Gardens on Friday afternoon to be on displayed at check in.
