



I am already thinking of how soon I can pull the boat out of storage and get the Vessel Safety Check from a Power Squadron Member. Thinking back to last season, when I tried to get a VSC, I discovered that of all the entities that offered them, our members provided far and away the most comprehensive one with the best service.

And going a bit further back to the last twelve months, we must raise our glass in the memory and tribute to those members who have had their LAST HORIZON last year. I will personally miss their knowledge, insights, cheer and good will.


